

LANCASTER COUNTY BOOK SCHOLARSHIP



The Lancaster County Commission for Higher Education will cover the cost of required books and class materials for Lancaster County residents participating in the Follett ACCESS Program.

When: 2023-2024 Academic Year, beginning Fall Semester 2023

Who: Students must be permanent residents of Lancaster County, South Carolina, at the time of awarding; admitted as a USC Lancaster student (Not Palmetto College); participating in the USCL Bookstore's "Follett ACCESS Program." Students who change their address after admission or registration may be required to provide proof of permanent county residency.

How: There is no application. The award only applies to USC Lancaster classes. Once billed, the Lancaster County Commission for Higher Education pays the charge. Students must maintain enrollment past the refund period.

Amount: Up to \$25/credit hour of USCL classes to cover all required books and class materials through the Follett ACCESS Program. Students cannot receive a refund for these expenses. Accommodations will be made for students with qualifying disabilities or impairments to obtain printed materials instead of online course materials.
